“When I was in Bangladesh I saw that the most effective form of work was that which embraces the culture of the people, rather than trying to replicate western structures and traditions.” Anna Harding, a teacher and musician, wrote these words after a Global Xposure visit to Bangladesh.

Tim, after a visit to India and Nepal and joining Global Interaction’s Unearthed gatherings, wrote, “These greatly challenged my existing worldview, and taught me to see the differences that exist between ‘culture’ and ‘Christianity’ in a missions context, and to question what is ‘essential’ or ‘negotiable’ in the way Christ is shared in a different culture.” Tim is a teacher, majoring in geography and environmental science.
